# **SANATAIN COURSE**

2 year Islamic studies diploma for sisters covering a range of Islamic sciences, both academic and practical.

## **Course OVERVIEW**

## Overview of the Sanatayn Course

**Sanatayn is a two year Islamic course specifically designed for adult sisters wishing to study core Islamic subjects. Delivered in English this comprehensive course will equip mature students with knowledge and deep understanding of Islam.**

The course content has been carefully selected so that key topics are studied and essential subjects covered in a short period of time. The course is delivered over two days a week in two hour lessons.

Lessons are delivered by qualified Alimahs in English and will cover the study of the following subjects:

- Translation and Commentary of the Holy Qur'an
- Study of the Prophetic Hadith
- Study of Fiqh and Masail relating to women
- Understanding of Aqaaid and Beliefs
- Seerah of Rasulullah ﷺ
- Learning Arabic conversation
- Tajweed – Rectifying the recitation of the Qur'an

On completion of this course students will have attained a sound understanding of the core tenets of Islam, which will equip them to meet the challenges of modern day life as a Muslim without compromising their religion

The course will help Muslim Sisters to learn about Islam from a foundation level to a higher level providing them with knowledge and understanding of Islam.

This will enable students to conduct their life in accordance with the commands of Allah and the Sunnah of His Prophet ﷺ.

We understand the demands of modern life and the busy lifestyle we live. We have therefore deliberately kept lessons short but focused, rich but not overwhelming, ensuring only very limited study outside of lessons is required.

By the end of the course students will have the satisfaction of practicing their Deen with the knowledge from the Qur'an and the Sunnah together with the ability to understand and translate parts of the Holy Qur'an and the Prophetic Hadith from Arabic.

## Who is the Target Audience for the Course?

This course is ideal for sisters who are unable to pursue the advanced Alimah & Qiraat Course but wish to acquaint themselves with the foundations of Islamic studies. It is an opportunity for students who have completed the Maktab syllabus and wish to progress further in learning Islamic studies and study basic Arabic language. This course can also serve as a taster to those wishing to enroll on our advanced Alimah and Qiraat courses.

## Structure

This course is a two-year, part-time program with each academic year commencing in September and ending in July. Each year is divided into three terms: the 1st term from September to December, the 2nd term from January to Ramadhan, and the final term beginning post-Ramadan to July.

Classes are conducted on-site at Tayyibah Girls School and expected to commence on Tuesday 16th September 2025. Further details will be given post-registration. Classes will be held three days a week, with each class session lasting for two hours, for a total of four hours per week. The timings displayed below are subject to change.

Timings: Tuesday & Thursday, 5.00pm – 7.00pm

In addition to the scheduled contact hours, students are expected to allocate a minimum of 2-4 hours per week to preparation and revision.

## Assessments

The evaluation of student performance throughout the academic year is conducted through termly assessments. These exams serve as a comprehensive evaluation of student mastery of the material covered during the year. The results of these assessments are used to determine students' final grades and provide feedback to students on areas where they may need to improve or where they have excelled.

## Entry Requirements

All students must be:

- Aged 13 or older
- Proficient in written and spoken English
- Hardworking, intellectually curious and committed to attending all sessions and completing the programme.

## Fees and Finance

The fee for each academic year is £300. Once committed to the course, the students can either pay one lump sum or over three instalments, paid termly.

## Language

- All lessons will be delivered in English. Students should also be able to read basic Arabic.

## Holidays

The classes will remain close during school term holidays, Ramadhan, Special Islamic Holidays and on Public Holidays

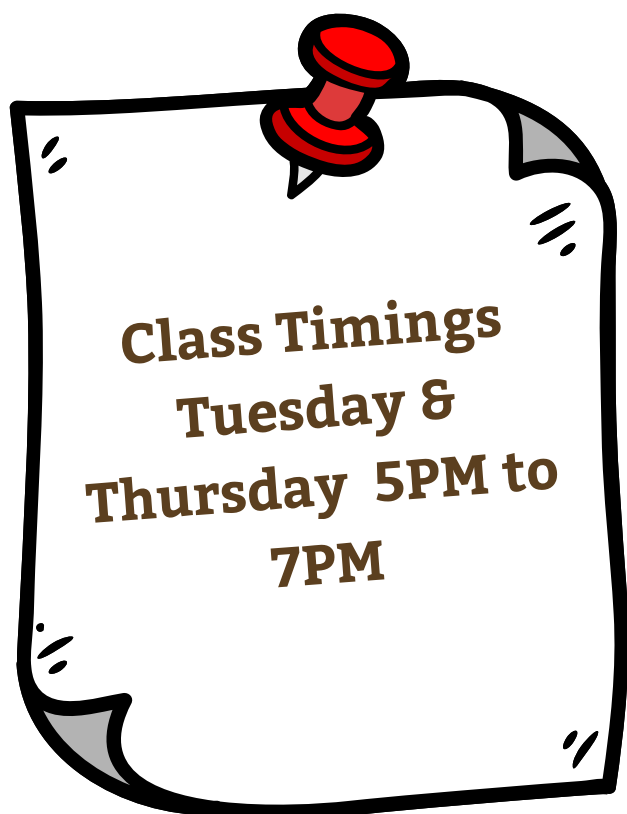

- Lay the groundwork for further Islamic study, should they wish to progress onto advanced courses.
