Overview of the Course

Sanatain is a two-year Islamic studies programme designed for sisters aged 13 and above who wish to gain a solid foundation in the core subjects of Islam. Delivered entirely in English by qualified Aalimahs, this course provides students with the essential knowledge and understanding needed to practise their faith with confidence.

The curriculum has been thoughtfully structured to cover key topics in a focused and accessible way, ensuring that important areas of Islamic learning are addressed within a manageable timeframe. The course runs two evenings a week, with engaging two-hour sessions that balance depth of learning with flexibility for busy schedules.

Subject	Text Used	Focus
Tafseer	Short Surahs (Juz Amma)	Word-by-word meaning, context, and practical lessons
Hadith	Provisions for the Seekers	Daily life application and spiritual development
Fiqh	Ascent to Felicity	Practical worship, purity, prayer, and lifestyle fiqh
Aqeedah	Classical Sunni Creed	Tawheed, Prophethood, belief in the unseen
Tajweed	IC Tassical Taiweed filles	Phonetics, rules of recitation, practical reading
Seerah	Prophet of Mercy	Life of the Prophet (peace be upon him), key events, moral lessons
Adab	Classical Adab texts (e.g., Bidayat al-Hidayah, Riyadh as-Saliheen sections)	Manners with people, parents, teachers, society



By the end of the two-year programme, students will:

- Develop a sound understanding of the key principles of Qur'an, Hadith, Fiqh, Aqeedah, Seerah, Tajweed, and Adab.
- Be able to apply Islamic teachings confidently and correctly in daily life, in line with the Qur'an and Sunnah.
- Strengthen their connection to Allah and His Messenger through knowledge, reflection, and practice.

Learning Objectives

- Improve their recitation of the Qur'an with correct pronunciation and Tajweed rules.
- Build confidence in their Islamic identity and gain the tools to navigate modern challenges without compromising their faith.
- Lay the groundwork for further Islamic study, should they wish to progress onto advanced courses.
